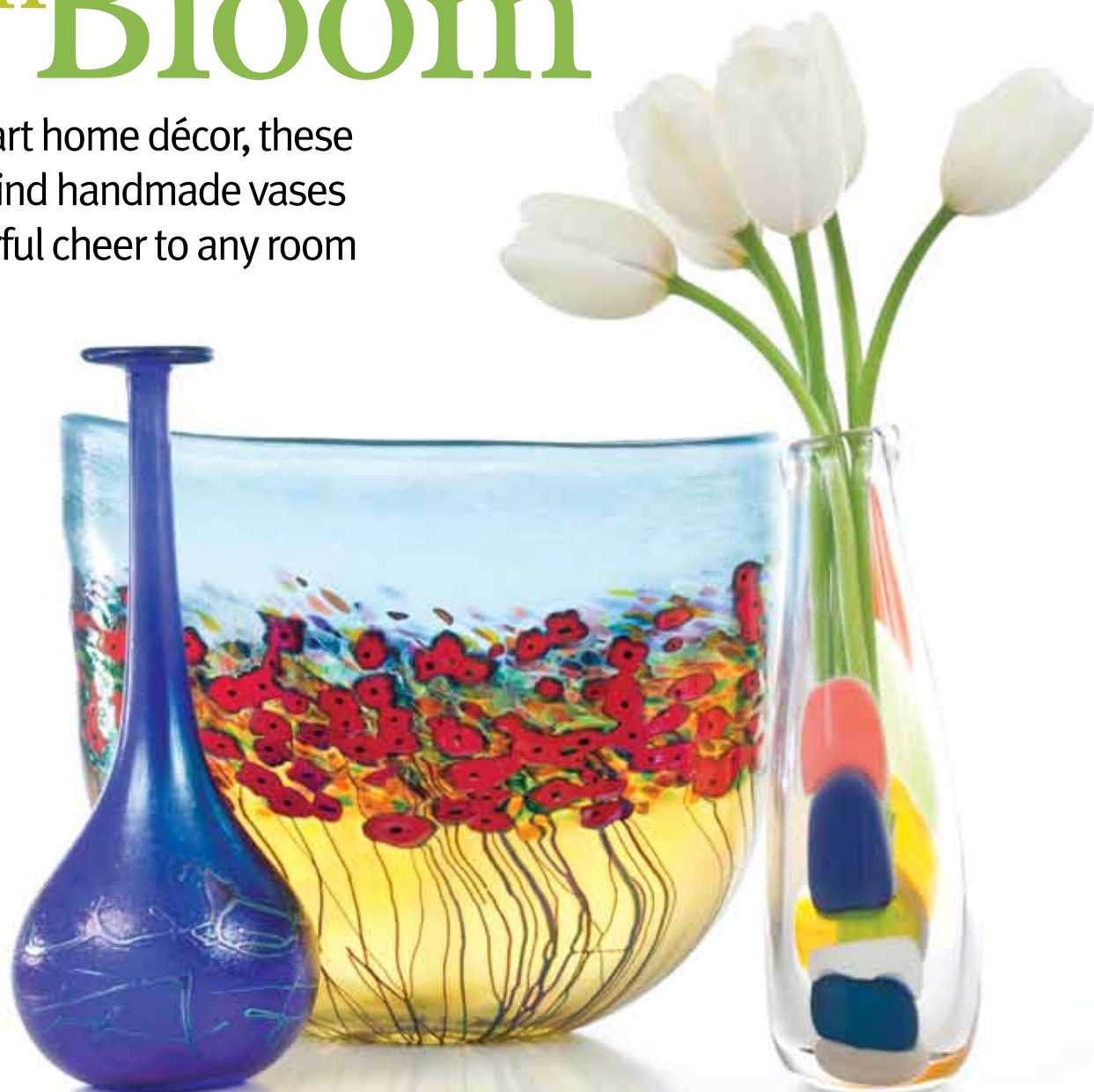


Art in Bloom
